View the film and compose the following about each: (1) Write one paragraph about the historical context of the movie (What era is being portrayed? Major time period/event? Clues from the movie to lead you to this?). Write a second paragraph about whether or not the movie is historically accurate. This may require some research as to what the times were actually like. Be sure to use specific details and scenes from the movie in your responses.**

**This assignment will be due on the second day of class. You may want to get to know some of your classmates for next year and watch the films together! However, make sure to do your own write-up. If there are any concerns or questions, I will be available through the summer by contacting me through my email address (at the top of the paper). Have fun!**
